SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS

COMPETENCY INSTRUCTOR

No instructor required

COMPETENCY ADULT

- a) Supervision category: Adult supervision required
- b) Min supervision age: 16 years or older
- c) Min Qualification/ Competency: Must have completed the Adult Supervision Training and assessed by Finlay Park Staff as competent to supervise the activities. Must be able to instruct participants and manage the area
- d) Min experience: none

EQUIPMENT

- a) Cell phone
- b) First Aid kit (groups are required to supply their own first aid needs, however FP does have supplies available)

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

COMPETENCY

- a) Minimum age: 5 years or older
- b) Minimum level of competency: Able to follow directions, and listen to instructions

EQUIPMENT

- a) Clothes: Togs, wetsuit, or cloths which will get wet.
- b) Foot wear: None needed
- c) Other:

SUPERVISION STRUCTURE

NUMBERS

Always one person at a time on the slide

RATIOS

Two adult supervisors

SUPERVISION POSITION

Adult supervisor must be at the launching platform, and one in the landing zone

RATIO SUPERVISION CHANGES

SPECIFIC SUPERVISION INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADULT HELPERS

- 1. One adult to control the slide top area
 - a. This person is in charge of who goes down and when.
 - b. Checking seating position of the participants
 - c. And releasing the person if all is clear
 - i. Check and make sure no one else is on slide
- 2. One adult to control the landing area



- a. To make sure participants get of the slide when stopped
- b. To support sliders who have landed
- c. To control the area

ACTIVITY IN OPERATION GENERAL EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND RESCUE SCENARIOS

Minor accidents (minor cuts, bruises)

- Administer first aid
- Assess whether activity can continue

Major accidents

- Administer first aid
- Stop the activity
- Contact the office for extra assistance or to call an ambulance
- Report ASAP to Director or Program manager or if not available other instructors.
